

Tauranga Indoor Radio Control Car Club (TIRCCC) Rules 2023

- 1. TIRCCC is affiliated to New Zealand Radio Control Association.
- 2. On-road and Off-road classes to be run, providing minimum of 4 cars to run the class.
- 3. TIRCCC members racing at other clubs should ensure their cars conform to that clubs rules.
- 4. Classes available to racers: Newcomers/ juniors, M-chassis, Super Stock 13.5 Blinky, 2WD Buggy 17.5, 2WD Buggy 10.5, 4WD 8.5 Buggy 4WD 17.5 Buggy, 2WD 17.5 Truck, 2WD 10.5 Truck, 2WD Short Course Truck, Tamiya Euro Trucks, Vintage Pre 95.
- 5. A minimum of 4 cars shall determine a race. The committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes of a similar nature for any reason it determines a benefit to the club.
- 6. No cars are to be driven on the track without a body shell.
- 7. No cars to be driven in reverse direction on the track.
- 8. All Lipo batteries to be charged at 1C and in a fire retardant bag.
- 9. No alcohol to be consumed during any meeting.
- 10. No smoking inside racing venue.
- 11. Drugs of any variety will not be tolerated, unless medically required.
- 12. No open toed shoes to be used while marshaling e.g. Jandals, or bare feet.
- 13. Parents are responsible for ensuring their children's safety, while racing, marshaling or outside of the venue. (Parents to be with younger children to help and advise when it is their turn to marshal)
- 14. Under no circumstance are Marshalls to be the subject to abuse of any sort.
- 15. Back to back racers need to organize a substitute marshal.
- 16. Marshals to be at their station one minute prior to next race. Marshal positions will be marked with numbers and drivers will marshal in their grid positions. Drivers in Grid positions 7 and above are not required to Marshal in the next race but are expected to volunteer marshal in other races.
- 17. Drivers who fail to marshal as per above will lose their fastest time in Qualifying and lose their points if in Finals.
- 18. Any member or parent of a member found to be bringing the club into disrepute via social media of any kind shall be suspended until such time as a committee meeting is convened and the matter fully discussed. Penalties to include; race bans and/or discontinued membership.
- 19. Committee members/race director's decision is final.

TIRCCC club championships.

- 1. Only financial club members can receive points towards the club championship.
- 2. To compete in the final event a driver must have competed in qualifying.
- 3. Final grid positions will be determined by best race results in Qualifying.
- 4. All cars to be run in "Blinky " mode.
- 5. Mini (M5) and rally car are to be raced as 'Out of the box". Any modification to be approved by the committee.



- 6. The club will endeavor to hold 10 races meets that counts in the club championships. 2 lowest scores will be drop in the final score. If there are less than 6 races held in the year, only the lowest score will be dropped in the final score. First three positions in each class will receive trophies.
- 7. Vintage Class will be run with open motor/modifications but no points will be counted and no trophies will be rewarded at the end of the season.
- 8. Grid position must be displayed on the front of the car for the final otherwise the car to be place at the rear of the grid.
